



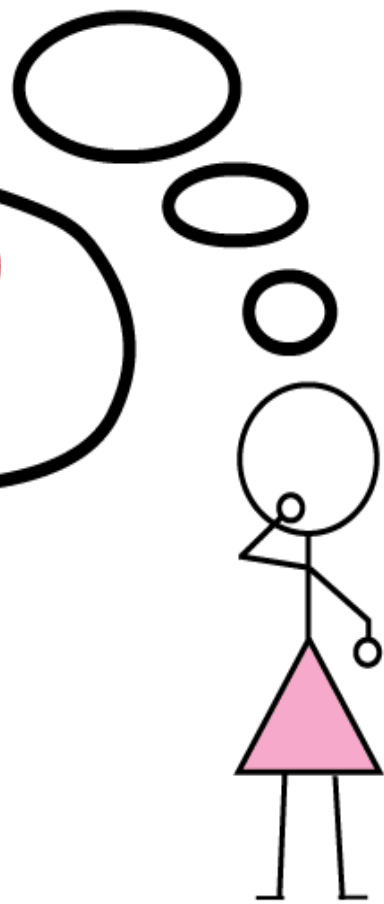

Understanding Leadership

What is leadership?

Leadership is the art of motivating a group of people to act toward achieving a common goal

Leadership captures the essentials of being able and prepared to inspire others.

Leadership requires others, and that implies they don't need to be "direct reports"

Effective leadership is based upon ideas—both original and borrowed—that are effectively communicated to others in a way that engages them enough to act as the leader wants them to act

Who is a leader?

- * A leader is someone who can see how things can be improved and who rallies people to move toward that **better vision**.
- * Leaders can work toward making their vision a reality while **putting people first**.
- * Leaders need to be **empathetic and connect** with people to be successful
- * Leaders don't have to come from the same background or follow the same path

Strategic Thinking

Developing a vision of where you want to be.

Planning & Delivery

Planning how to achieve your vision and dealing with challenges along the way.

People Management

Finding the right people and motivating them to work towards your vision.

Change Management

Recognising, responding and managing changes to your vision and plans.

Communication

Working on the best ways to communicate your vision to others and listening to ideas.

Persuasion & Influence

Encouraging others to help you achieve your vision by demonstrating its advantages.



Types Of Leadership Styles

5 Different Types of Leadership styles



- ✓ Authoritarian leadership styles allow a leader to impose expectations and define outcomes
- ✓ Although this is an efficient strategy in time-constrained periods, creativity will be sacrificed since input from the team is limited.



- ✓ Participative leadership styles are rooted in democratic theory.
- ✓ The essence is to involve team members in the decision making process.
- ✓ However, it can be a time-consuming process to reach a consensus

5 Different Types of Leadership styles



- ✓ Situational leadership is all about adapting. In today's climate, it may be the best style of leadership to draw upon
- ✓ Situational Leadership is not based on a specific skill of the leader; instead, he or she modifies the style of management to suit the requirements



- ✓ Transactional leadership styles use "transactions" between a leader and his or her followers to get the job done
- ✓ The leader sets clear goals, and team members know how they'll be rewarded for their compliance
- ✓ Empathy is not valued

5 Different Types of Leadership styles

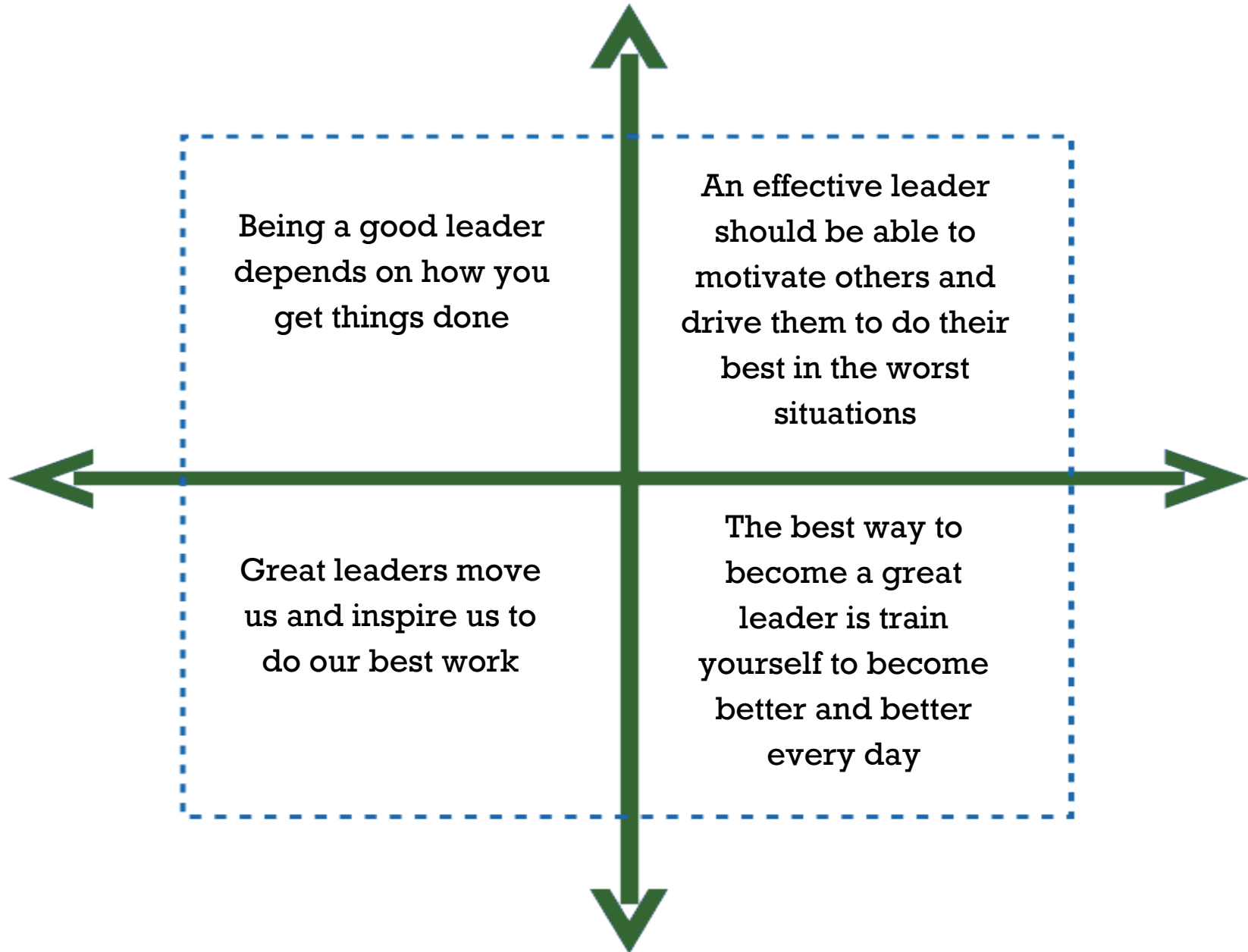


- ✓ The leader inspires his or her followers with a vision and then encourages and empowers them to achieve it
- ✓ Transformational leadership can sometimes lead to the deviation of protocols and regulations

COMMUNICATE..

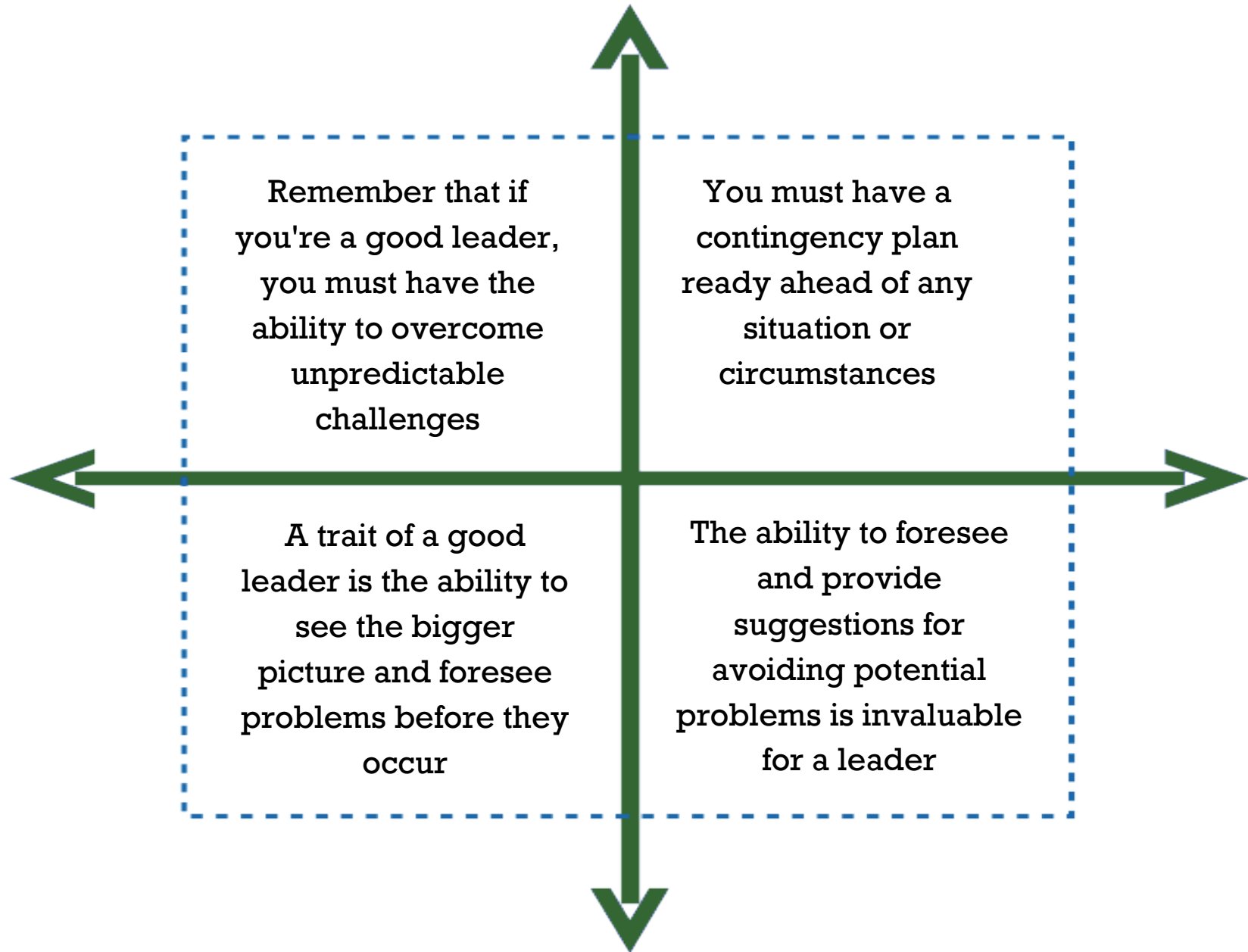
You can solve most problems and overcome most obstacles if you are a good communicator

Even someone who excels in many aspects of leadership will probably hit a ceiling if he or she is not a good communicator

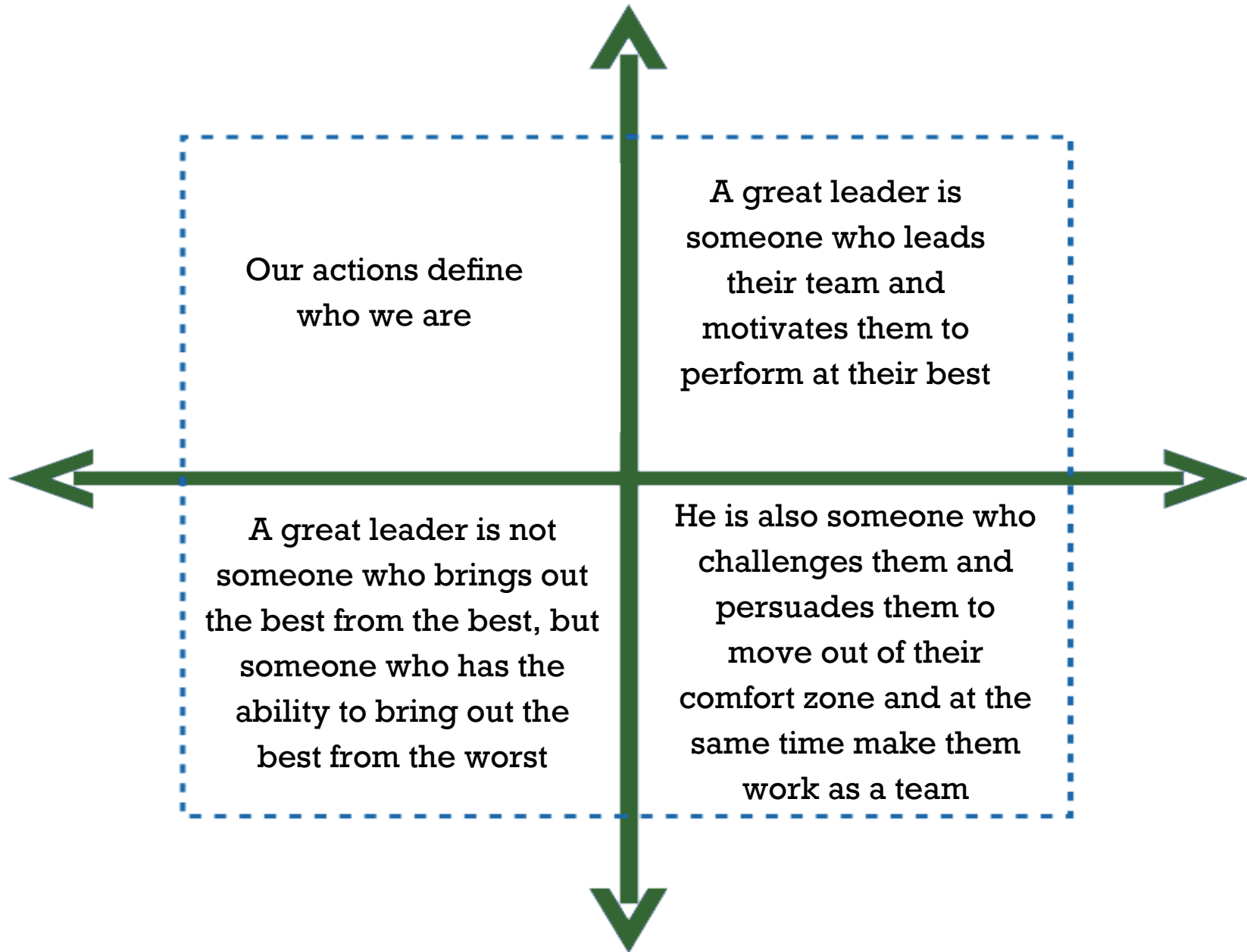
A good communicator is not just a great speaker but a great listener too
